

How to ...

Fixing Large Format Tiles onto Sand:Cement Screed/Concrete



- 1. Ensure the sand:cement screed or concrete is fully cured, flat and clean.
- 2. If the base is porous, prime with diluted Nicobond Primer in ratio 4 volumes of water to 1 volume of Nicobond Primer and allow to dry.
- 3. Apply a layer of adhesive from 4mm up to 30mm thick onto the base using the 20mm half round Nicobond Large Format Notched Trowel.
- 4. Place the tiles into the wet adhesive using a slight sliding action to ensure solid bedding of the tiles.
- 5. The Nicobond Professional Levelling System should be used to ensure tiles are flat and level.
- 6. Fill joints between tiles using recommended grout.
- * Allow at least 6 weeks for structural concrete floors to cure and further 3 weeks for subsequently applied screed. In the event that a rapid setting cement replacement is used the drying time of screed will be greatly reduced. Refer to the Technical Team for further information.
- * It should be noted that a large format tile is a tile with no tile edge greater than 1200mm or a facial area greater then 3600cm²
